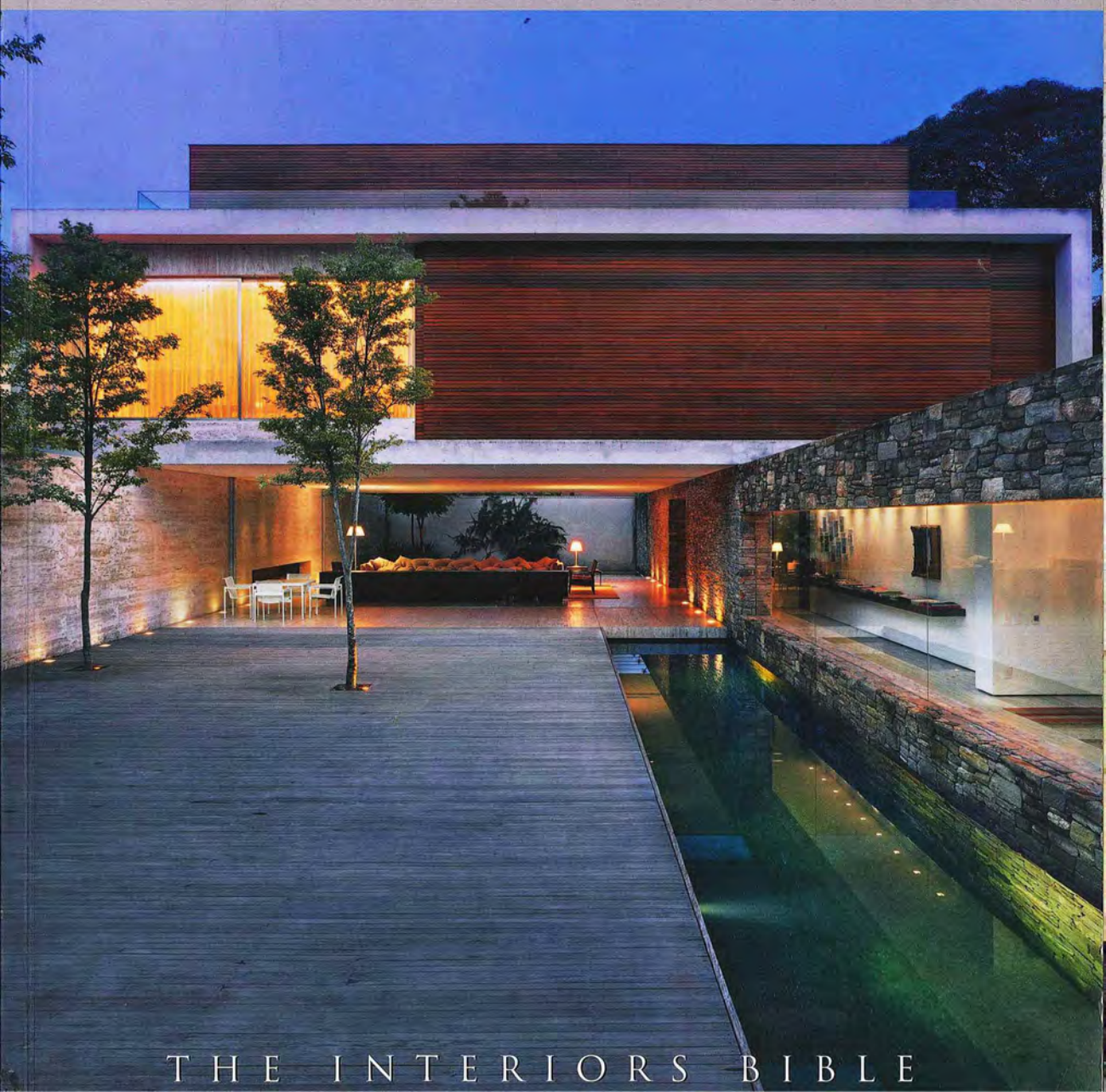

THE INTERIORS BIBLE

Subtle period design references abound amongst contemporary design in this apartment and the bright bespoke kitchen with its grey and white colour palette is no exception. The sleek lacquered units in metallic shades from Italian kitchen designers, Pedini, with Miele and Gaggenau built-in appliances, including a dedicated wine unit, sit comfortably in the room amidst a decorative plasterwork ceiling and frosted windows with stained glass motifs which acknowledge the building's original design. Overhead hangs a Venetian glass chandelier with delicate fluted cups, reminiscent of early 20th century lights and hand-crafted by London-based specialists in Murano glass, Mediterraneo.





In the apartment there are three large bedrooms all with en-suite bathrooms, along with a study/staff bedroom and separate shower suite.





It is this section of the apartment that the team has decorated and furnished with an exuberantly glamorous flourish, culminating in a deliberately ostentatious master bedroom suite which was converted from an entire wing of small, pokey rooms into a flowing suite of walk-in wardrobe, study, bedroom and amazing bathroom with rain shower and stunning copper free-standing bath from WestOne Bathrooms. Colours are dramatic – dark chocolate and rich metallics are offset by sumptuous grey velvet and white silk. The gold floor tiles are hand-made ceramics with a lustre glaze and the wall tiles are gold-finished cement, both from Charles Stone, while the Fendi Gallia bed is from Interior Supply.
